You will find a list of content of the above courses attached to this newsletter. This gives an indication of the topics covered in each course.

It is essential that students identify which Office Program they have on their own computer, as the toolbar dropdown menu (2003) and ribbon menu (2007/2010) are taught in different classes. If you are unsure, there is an example of each method on the noticeboard at the club rooms. Also, if you come to the Help Session (see below) a tutor can help you understand this. It is strongly advised that students wishing to undertake any of the additional courses have at least completed Course 1 – Basic Computing, otherwise they may find these courses too complex to understand.

Seniors Week Open Day – this will be held at the club rooms on Wednesday 20 March, 10 am – 2.00 pm. Bring your family, friends and neighbours to see what can be done with a computer, and some useful and practical applications.
