We are now teaching the operating system Windows7 and Office 2010 in addition to our normal ones (2003, 2007) – anyone purchasing a new computer nowadays will most likely have this system installed – don't worry, you can learn all of our classes at the club using the same system as you have on your new computer. At the time of going to press there are vacancies in most of the following courses, so call in to the club and put your name down on a list and get in early to the class of your choice. Please write clearly - we all have eyesight problems occasionally!!!

The titles of our Basic Computing and Word Processing courses are numbered, to indicate the progression of difficulty.

- ♦ Course 1 Basic Computing Office 2003 OR Office 2007/2010: (six weeks course) Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday
- ♦ Course 2 Word 2003 OR Word 2007/2010): (four weeks course) Monday, Thursday and Friday
- ♦ Course 3 Word 2003 OR Word 2007/2010: (seven weeks course): Monday and Thursday

Additional Courses:

- ♦ **Desktop Publishing Using Word:** Tuesday afternoons (five weeks)
- **Digital Photography:** Monday and Thursdays, mornings and afternoons
- Internet/Email: Thursday and Wednesday mornings, Friday afternoons (four weeks)
- ♦ Introduction to Excel: Thursday mornings (six weeks)
- ♦ Understanding Your Computer: Tuesdays (for more advanced students)
- ♦ The Club also provides a service for members of transferring slides/transparencies to a CD: Tuesday and Thursday

It is essential that students identify which Office Program they have on their own computer, as the toolbar dropdown menu (2003) and ribbon menu (2007/2010) are taught in different classes. If you are unsure, there is an example of each method on the noticeboard at the club rooms. Also, if you come to the Help Session (see below) a tutor can help you understand this.

It is strongly advised that students wishing to undertake any of the additional courses have at least completed Course 1 – Basic Computing, otherwise they may find these courses too complex to understand.

These courses are only available to financial members for 2011 – check that you have paid your membership fee.

COMPUTER HELP SESSIONS: Thursday 14 July, and Thursday 11 August 2-4 pm. Make use of these sessions, as tutors of various courses will be there to answer your queries and give you a hand using your computer. Also, someone will be there to help you identify the toolbar dropdown menu and ribbon menu systems.
