The CPST group learned about the significant security arrangements that are in place within the site - and seeing this in practice as access (apart from normal requirements) included finger print identification. Consistent and reliable power supply is also critical to the smooth operation of the facility which includes back up power supply and fire risk mitigation processes. The tour was extremely well presented and thoroughly enjoyed by the CPST group.
