Do you have a My Health Record?



- From February 2019, everyone in Australia with a Medicare card was automatically given a My Health Record. Unless you decided to opt-out you probably have one.
- If you have arrived in Australia recently, you may have selected to have a record.
- If you are a person who does not have Medicare or Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) benefits, you may still be able to register for a My Health Record.



What is the my health app?

my health is an application which can be used to access key health information in My Health Record.

- You can install and use the my health app on a mobile device wherever you have an internet connection.
- The my health app lets you download documents from My Health Record onto your mobile device.
- The app also lets you share documents that contain your health information with other people or organisations.



Why use the My Health App

You use the My Health app instead of the MyGov website for easier, mobile-first access to your My Health Record information. It allows you to view health data, manage electronic prescriptions, and find services directly from your phone.

While the MyGov platform allows for managing and updating your record, the My Health app focuses on convenient, user-friendly, "view-only" access to the information already within your record.
